Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives of Amrit Sarovar Mission;**
- (b) whether it is true that 75 Amrit Sarovars are going to be identified from each district of the country for their manifestation;**
- (c) if so, the number of Amrit Sarovars (Ponds) identified from each district of the State of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana; and**
- (d) the details of timelines by when Amrit Sarovars are going to be manifested?**

(a): The Mission Amrit Sarovar was launched on 24th April 2022, with an objective to conserve water for the future. The Mission aimed at developing / rejuvenating 75 Amrit Sarovar (Pond) in each district of the Country, totaling about 50,000 Amrit Sarovars in the country. Amrit Sarovar has been a visible manifestation of the actions during Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav.

(b)&(c): The initial target of the Mission Amrit Sarovar for all States/ UTs was 50,000 (at least 75 Amrit Sarovar in every rural district of the country).

(d): The target of 50,000 Amrit Sarovar was achieved on the 10th May 2023. The Mission has Started on 24th April 2022 and ended on 15th August, 2023.
