STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO 720 BY SHRI PRATAP CHANDRA SARANGI TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 07.02.2024 REGARDING FENCING OF RAILWAY TRACKS

(a) to (d): Total 5 consequential train accidents took place involving stray cattle on track over Indian Railway during the last two years (2021-22 & 2022-23).

Existing provisions stipulate fencing at vulnerable locations for speed above 110 kmph to 130 kmph, and all along the track for speed above 130 kmph.

Details of fencing of railway track are maintained Railway Zone-wise and not State-wise as Railway Zones are spread beyond State boundaries. Zone wise details of fencing provided along Railway tracks are as under:
