STOPPAGE OF TRAIN AT BORIVALI/MALAD

782. SHRI MOHANBHAI KALYANJI KUNDARIYA:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that a significant portion of the population in Saurashtra region resides in close proximity to Borivali and Malad Stations;**
- (b) if so, whether any representations have been received requesting the inclusion of stoppage for train no. 12267/68 Mumbai Central-Hapa Duranto Express at Borivali or Malad;**
- (c) if so, the action taken thereon; and**
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor and the estimates time required for further consideration of the stoppage request?**

(a) to (d) Representations, including from Hon'ble Member of Parliament, have been received for provision of stoppage of 12267/68 Mumbai Central-Hapa Duronto Express at Borivali. Borivali station is presently being served by 75 pairs of train services. Presently, 10 pairs of trains are providing connection for Hapa from the Mumbai area. Malad is a sub-urban station near Borivali. Besides, provision of stoppages of trains is an on-going process on Indian Railways subject to operational feasibility, traffic justification etc.
