DELAYED INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

796. MS. RAMYA HARIDAS:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) the details of the number of delayed and cancelled infrastructure projects including highways, railways, power, coal etc., during the last five years, year and sector-wise;

(b) the details of cost overruns due to delay and cancellation of various infrastructure projects, sector-wise;

(c) the details of the infrastructure projects which have been delayed for more than five years;

(d) whether the original Date of Commissioning (D.O.C) for various infrastructure projects is not provided by the Government; and

(e) if so, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a) The Infrastructure and Project Monitoring Division (IPMD) of the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation is mandated to monitor time and cost overruns of Ongoing Central Sector Infrastructure Projects costing Rs.150 crores and above, based on the information provided by the project implementing agencies on Online Computerized Monitoring System (OCMS). The details of the number of delayed projects sector-wise during the last five years and the current year are at Annexure A.

- (b) As per latest Report for the month of December, 2023 published by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, 848 projects are delayed and the cost overrun in these delayed projects is 26.53%. The sector-wise details of these delayed projects with their costs is at Annexure B.
- (c) Out of total 848 delayed projects, 70 projects have been delayed by more than five years. The detail of these projects is available at www.cspm.gov.in
- (d) & (e) As per the data available on the portal of this Ministry all of the projects have Original/Anticipated Date of Commissioning.
