Centrally Sponsored Schemes

Will the Minister of SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY विज्ञान और प्रौद्योगिकी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Centrally Sponsored Schemes and Central Sector Schemes being implemented by the Government in the State of Telangana during the last five years and the current year, year-wise, schemewise and district-wise;
- (b) the details of the funds allocated, sanctioned, released and utilized for each of the above scheme during the last five years and the current year, yearwise, scheme-wise and district-wise;
- (c) the details of the physical targets set and achieved while implementing above schemes during the last five years and the current year, year-wise, scheme-wise and district-wise;
- (d) whether the Government found any shortcomings while implementing above schemes and if so, the manner in which the Government fixed those shortcomings;
- (e) Whether there is time and cost overrun of any of the above scheme; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) The schemes of the Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India (GoI) are Central Sector Schemes and the Ministry does not implement the Centrally Sponsored Schemes. The Ministry is implementing several Central Sector Schemes on Science and Technology (S&T) on PAN India basis through three main departments of the Ministry namely the Department of Science and Technology (DST), the Department of Biotechnology (DBT) and the Department

of Scientific and Industrial Research (DSIR)/ Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR).

DST plays a pivotal role in promotion of S&T in the country. The programmes of DST are being implemented under the following umbrella schemes:

- i. S&T Institutional & Human Capacity Building
- ii. Research and Development
- iii. Innovation, Technology Development and Deployment
- iv. National Mission on Interdisciplinary Cyber-Physical Systems

DBT is implementing two Central Sector Schemes namely 'Biotechnology R&D' scheme, and 'Industrial & Entrepreneurial Development' at pan-India level including Telangana.

DSIR is implementing Industrial Research and Development (IRD) schemes namely Promoting Innovations in Individuals, Start-ups and MSMEs (PRISM), Patent Acquisition and Collaborative Research & Technology Development (PACE), Building Industrial R&D and Common Research Facilities (BIRD-crf) and Access to Knowledge for Technology Development and Dissemination (A2K+).

(b) to (c): The details of funds sanctioned, released, and utilized under the aforementioned schemes in the State of Telangana, as well as the physical targets set and achieved during the last five years and the current year are provided in the below table:
