PMKSY IN BIHAR

Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the irrigation proposal submitted under the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) for Saran district in Bihar is under consideration and lying pending with the Central Water Commission, if so, the details thereof and the time by which such proposals are likely to be approved;
- (b) whether it is a fact that the Union Government has made the Budgetary provisions for various schemes under PMKSY; and
- (c) if so, the details of the schemes and progress made therein, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) Pre-feasibility report (PFR) of a proposed project on Irrigation, flood control and drainage in Saran district (phase 1) submitted by Government of Bihar, is currently under appraisal in Central Water Commission (CWC). The compliance on observations raised by CWC is awaited from Government of Bihar. Based on the same, process for acceptance of the PFR can be taken up by the screening committee of CWC to enable preparation of detailed project report by the State Government.

(b) & (c) Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) was launched during the year 2015-16, with an aim to enhance physical access of water on farm and expand cultivable area under assured irrigation, improve on-farm water use efficiency, introduce sustainable water conservation practices, etc. It is an umbrella scheme, consisting of two major components being implemented by this Ministry, namely, Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP), and Har Khet Ko Pani (HKKP). HKKP, in turn, consists of four sub-components, being Command Area Development & Water Management (CAD&WM), Surface Minor Irrigation (SMI), Repair, Renovation and Restoration (RRR) of Water Bodies, and Ground Water (GW) Development component. In addition, PMKSY also consists of Watershed Development component (WDC) which is being implemented by Department of Land Resources, Ministry of Rural Development.

Per Drop More Crop (PDMC) component being implemented by Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare was also a component of PMKSY during 2016-21, which is now being implemented separately.

Further in December, 2021, implementation of PMKSY for the period of 2021-22 to 2025-26 has been approved by Govt. of India with an outlay of Rs. 93,068 crore.
