PARKING OF AIRCRAFTS AT AIRPORTS

- (a) whether the Government is aware that there is constraint of space in parking of aircrafts at different airports in the country and if so, the details thereof, airport-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has given any advisory to airlines in this regard as some of the airlines are awaiting delivery of new aircrafts and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the details of steps taken by the Government to ease parking of aircrafts?

(a) to (c): Presently, the airlines are not facing parking issues at airports. Further, upgradation of infrastructure including construction of parking stands at airports is a continuous process and is undertaken by the Airports Authority of India and other Airport Operators from time to time depending on the availability of land, traffic demand etc.
