# (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) and (b) The Ministry keeps on receiving proposals from various State Governments / Union Territories (UTs), including State Government of Uttar Pradesh, for declaration / upgradation of State

Roads, including State Highways (SHs), as new National Highways (NHs). The Ministry considers declaration of some State Roads, including SHs, as NHs from time to time based on the fulfillment of the criteria for declaration of NHs, requirement of connectivity, interse priority and availability of funds.

About 14 numbers of state roads including SHs and greenfield alignment in 923 km length were notified as new NHs in the State of Uttar Pradesh during last five years (FY 2018-19 to 2022-23).

About 3,959 km length of NHs, including newly notified NHs, were developed/ constructed in the State of Uttar Pradesh during last five years and the total expenditure incurred was about Rs. 83,755 crore.

(c) Development and maintenance of NHs, including newly notified NHs, is a continuous process and works are accordingly taken up to keep the NHs in traffic worthy conditions depending upon inter-se priority, traffic density and availability of funds.
