- (c) the steps taken by the Government to provide LPG connection to all rural households in the country including in Chatra, Latehar and Panki districts of Jharkhand?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 296 BY SHRI SUNIL KUMAR SINGH TO BE ANSWERED ON 9TH DECEMBER 2019 REGARDING 'REDUCTION IN CONSUMPTION OF KEROSENE'.

- (a) The target of providing 8 crore deposit free LPG connections to adult women of poor households under Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY) has been achieved in September, 2019. The State/UT-wise details including the State of Jharkhand are at Annexure-I.
- (b) In view of increase in LPG coverage, the allocation of PDS Kerosene has been rationalized across the country and decreasing over the years. The allocation made to States/UTs from year 2017-18 to 2019-20 (upto the 3rd Quarters) are at Annexure-II.
- (c) Release of LPG connections is a continuous process. LPG distributors are under instructions to immediately register any request for new LPG connection and Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) endeavour to release the same within 7 working days. As on 01.11.2019, there are 27.44 crore LPG customers in the country which cover 96.6 % households including Chatra, Latehar and Panki districts of Jharkhand.
