Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken by the Government to spread higher education and employment oriented vocational education in backward and border areas of the country;
- (b) whether the Government has issued any guidelines to the State Governments in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to open a new Central University in Pithoragarh, a backward and border area of Uttarakhand so that students of this area do not have to migrate to other places for higher education;
- (d) If so, the time by which the said University is likely to be set up in Pithoragarh; and
- (e) If not, the reasons therefor?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (e) OF THE LOK SABHA

TAMTA, HON'BLE M.P. REGARDING VOCATIONAL EDUCATION**

(a): There are various steps being taken by the Government to spread higher education in the country including backward and border areas. The details of Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) funded higher education institutions in border states is given in annexure-I. Also, MHRD in 2013 launched a Centrally Sponsored Scheme named Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) with an objective of correcting the regional imbalances in terms of access to higher education by setting up institutions in un-served and underserved areas of the country. The detail of state-wise/UTs funds approved under RUSA from the year 2013 to till date is placed at

annexure-II.

Further, to provide greater access to employment oriented vocational education throughout the country, including backward regions and border areas, the steps being taken in this regard is placed at Annexure-III.

In addition, Ministry of Human Resource Development is working along with Sector Skill Councils (SSCs) under National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) to undertake Apprenticeship/Internship embedded degree programmes with core focus on development of knowledge, skills, aptitude and on-job training. Some of the sectors like Logistics & Retail have commenced Degree Apprenticeship programmes in 15 institutions.

(b): 'Education' being a concurrent subject, the State Governments may also take initiatives in spreading the higher education and skill oriented education through their own institutional network as per UGC guidelines.

(c), (d) & (e): At present, there are 5 higher education institutions including 1 Central University in Uttarakhand. Opening of Central Universities is a continuous process and the proposals are examined on the basis of need for the region, existing infrastructure and resources available.
