(a) to (c): As per the information provided by the Ministry of Panchayati Raj, based on the data uploaded by the State Panchayat Raj Departments in the website specifically maintained by National Informatics Centre for Local Government Directory, the number of villages which qualified and were notified as urban towns during the financial year 2017-18 and 2018-19 are 1304 and 1524 respectively which represents an increase of 220 villages notified as urban towns during 2018-19 over 2017-18.
