STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO PARAS (a) & (b) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. †*342 TO BE ANSWERED ON 12.12.2019 ON “Dams and Reservoirs near National Parks” RAISED BY SHRI MANSUKHBHAI DHANJIBHAI VASAVA, M.P.

Central Water Commission maintains national register of large dams as per information received from State Governments/ Dam owners from time to time. This register is constantly updated and available at URL <http://cwc.gov.in/national-register-large-dams>.

As per National Water Informatics Centre (NWIC) - GIS data base, for few National Parks, Birds & Wildlife Sanctuaries for which point data (without physical extent & boundary) is available on GIS maps, the major & medium reservoirs in the vicinity of 1 km, 3 km, 5km & 10 km is attached at **Annexure**.

All river valley projects require prior environmental clearance from the Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF & CC). The environmental clearance process also determines comprehensive Terms of Reference (TOR) for addressing all relevant environmental concerns for the preparation of an Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Report in respect of the project or activity for which prior environmental clearance is sought. Preparation of Environmental Management Plan is also required for formulation, implementation and monitoring of environmental protection measures during and after commissioning of projects. Further, Forest and Wild Life clearance is also required to be obtained for clearance of projects and is subject to compliance of conditions imposed while granting such clearances.
