SPECIAL PACKAGE TO CHHATTISGARH

1103. SHRI CHUNNI LAL SAHU:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any provision to provide special package to State Governments to tackle dangerous diseases like Malaria and Dengue;

(b) if so, the details of the fund allocated to States/UTs and utilized by them particularly in Chhattisgarh during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;

(c) if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether the Government proposes to set up more hospitals to tackle the said diseases in Chhattisgarh; and

(e) if so, the details thereof, location-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a): Directorate of National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme provides technical guidance and financial support for specified activities/items for only vector borne diseases as per NHM norms. The prevention and control of the vector borne diseases is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments.

(b) & (c): The Details of the allocation & amp; expenditure to state of Chhattisgarh are as below:-

(d) & (e): Government of India (GoI) has identified following Seven hospitals as requested by the State Government to function as Sentinel Surveillance Hospitals for Dengue to provide free diagnosis in the State of Chhattisgarh.

- 1. Pt. J.N.M Medical College, Raipur
- 2. Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel District Hospital, Bilaspur
- 3. Jagdalpur Medical College (Maharani Hospital), Jagdalpur, Bastar
- 4. District Hospital, Ambikapur, Surguja
- 5. Medical College, Rajnandgaon
- 6. Medical College, Raigarh
- 7. District Hospital, Korba

GoI provides dengue test kits to these hospitals free of cost. Till date, total 37 IgM ELISA kits for Dengue (1 Kit- 96 tests) are supplied to these identifies hospitals as per their technical requirement.

Further, Under the aegis of Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) AIIMS Raipur a teaching cum tertiary care Institute been established at Raipur, Chhattisgarh with an sanctioned cost of Rs. 820 crore. The AIIMS is functional and providing medical services to tackle all types of diseases including malaria and dengue. Currently 700 beds are functional and average OPD attendance is around 1750.

Apart from AIIMS, two State Government owned Medical Colleges at Bilaspur and Jagdalpur in Chhattisgarh are being upgraded through PMSSY with sanctioned cost of Rs. 200 crore each. Total number of beds to be added is around (289X2=) 578.
