Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDMS)

117. SHRI TAPIR GAO:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of manpower engaged for Mid Day Meal Scheme (MDMS) in Schools;
- (b) the total strength of Mid Day Meal Scheme staff working all over the country, State-wise;
- (c) the number of days in a week and number of months they are working in a year;
- (d) the details of honorarium paid to each staff engaged in the MDMS; and
- (e) whether there is any uniformity in the honorarium to MDMS staff and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) to (e): Under the Mid-Day Meal Scheme (MDMS) one cook-cum-helper (CCH) can be engaged for upto 25 students, two cook-cum-helpers (CCHs) for schools with 26 to 100 students and one additional cook-cum-helper for every addition of up to 100 students. As against approval of 26.09 lakh cook-cum-helpers under the scheme during 2018-19, 24.95 lakh cook-cum-helpers have been engaged by the States and Union Territories. The State and UT-wise details of CCHs engaged under the scheme are given at Annexure -I.

CCHs engaged under the Scheme for preparing and serving mid-day meals at schools, are honorary workers who have come forward for rendering social services. In recognition of their services, the CCHs are paid Rs.1000 per month for 10 months in a year. Honorarium is also provided to CCHs for preparing and serving mid day meals in elementary schools during summer vacation in drought affected areas notified by the concerned State Governments. The details of the honorarium paid to the CCHs working under MDMS in all States and Union Territories during 2018-19 are given at Annexure-II. The honorarium expenditure is shared between the Central Government and States and UTs as per the approved sharing pattern. Some State Governments and UT Administrations also supplement the honorarium by providing additional funds from their own resources.
