KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN DARBHANGA, BIHAR

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- whether the Government proposes to open new Kendriya Vidyalaya in Benipur and Birul block in Darbhanga where adequate land is available and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether a Kendriya Vidyalaya is temporarily running at Darbhanga Air Force Station in the absence of the building for the last few years and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to run the Kendriya Vidyalaya in Laheriasarai and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) & (b) Proposals for opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India/State Governments / Union Territories Administrations thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as the availability of necessary sanction of the Government. The proposals received from various sponsoring authorities for opening of new KVs also have to compete among other proposals under the "Challenge Method".

No proposal in prescribed proformae for opening of a new KV at Benipur and Birul block in Darbhanga has been received from the Government of Bihar so far.

(c) Yes, Sir. KV No. 2 Darbhanga (Bihar) is running temporarily in the 2nd Shift of permanent school building of KV No.1 AFS, Darbhanga (Bihar).

Necessary action for providing permanent school building for this KV can be taken up on transfer of minimum 5.00 acres of suitable piece of land in the name of KV by the State Government as per norms and availability of adequate funds for the purpose.

(d) The State Government of Bihar has proposed only 4 acres of land at Mauja-Taralahi, Block-Bahadurpur, Darbhanga in place of the minimum requirement of 5.00 acres. Hence the proposal has not been accepted by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan.
