- (a) whether the Government proposes to open Kendriya Vidyalayas in minorities dominated areas across the country; and
- (b) if so, the names of the areas which have been identified to open these Kendriya Vidyalayas?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) No such proposal is under consideration at present. The Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government employees including Defence and Para–Military personnel by providing a common programme of education.
