GUIDELINES UNDER PMKVY OF CHHATTISGARH

†1371. SHRI CHUNNI LAL SAHU:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any new guidelines have been issued by the Government to promote Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in the country under Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of Skill Development Centres being operated by the Government in the State of Chhattisgarh at present and the number of trained persons who have been provided employment opportunities so far;
- (d) the amount of funds allocated by the Government to the State for the said purpose during the last two years and the current year including the amount of funds utilised; and
- (e) the reasons for not utilising the allocated funds in case it is so?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI R. K. SINGH)

- (a) and (b) The guidelines for implementation of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (2016-20) were issued by the government to promote Skill Development and Entrepreneurship in the country in 2016.
- (c) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (2016-20) does not mandate the establishment of skill development centres. The scheme provides for taking up Short Term Training (STT) courses and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) through accredited and affiliated training centers (TCs) throughout the country. Under the scheme, empanelment of TCs is done through the process of accreditation and affiliation for respective job roles on digital platform known as SMART (Skill Management and Accreditation of Training Centres). As on 11.11.2019, 166 TCs have

been empanelled under PMKVY 2016-20 in the State of Chhattisgarh. Out of which, 59 TCs are currently operational.

Ministry promotes establishment of model and aspirational skill centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) in every district for imparting skill training through PMKVY 2016-20. As on 11.11.2019, 27 PMKKs have been allocated and all of them have been established in State of Chhattisgarh.

As on 11.11.2019, 0.94 lakh candidates (0.76 lakh in STT and 0.18 lakh in RPL) have been trained under PMKVY 2016-20 in the State of Chhattisgarh. Under STT, as per data reported on SDMS (Skill Development Management System), as on 11.11.2019, 56,341 candidates are certified. Out of these candidates, 20,807 candidates have been reported to be placed in various sectors.

(d) and (e) PMKVY has two components known as Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) being implemented by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) being implemented by State Skill Development Missions of the States/ UTs popularly known as State- Engagement Component of PMKVY (2016-20).

Under CSCM component of PMKVY 2016-20, there is no provision of State-wise or district-wise funds allocation. However, under CSSM component of PMKVY 2016-20, 25% of the funds and corresponding physical targets of PMKVY 2016-20 have been allocated to the States for the implementation of scheme through State Skill Development Missions across the State covering all districts. Under this component, after evaluation of proposal received from Chhattisgarh State Skill Development Authority (CSSDA), Government of Chhattisgarh, Ministry has given in-principle approval of a total target of 48,532 candidates and corresponding financial allocation of Rs. 71.16 Cr. for FY 2016-20, out of which, Rs. 35.57 Cr. has been released to Government of Chhattisgarh for the implementation of CSSM component of the Scheme in State of Chhattisgarh covering all districts. However, after rationalisation, the fund allocated for State of Chhattisgarh has been reduced to Rs. 53.37 Cr.
