(a) to (c): There are 239 proposals recommended by various High Courts
Collegiums for appointment of High Court Judges, which are under various

stages of processing with the Government and Supreme Court Collegium as per the procedure prescribed in Memorandum of Procedure (MoP).

At present, no proposal of elevation of Supreme Court Judge and appointment of Chief Justice of High Court is pending.
