Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated to Southern Railway for the fitting, installation and commissioning of CCTV cameras in various railway stations in the Tamil Nadu during the last five years, year-wise;**
- (b) whether all railway stations in Tamil Nadu are under CCTV camera surveillance; and**
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?**

(a): The funds allocated to Southern Railway for providing Close Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras in various railway stations in Tamil Nadu during last five years are:-

Year	Fund allocation
2015-16	₹8.26 Crore
2016-17	₹22.14 Crore
2017-18	₹1.59 Crore
2018-19	₹1.59 Crore
2019-20	₹19.54 Crore

(b) and (c): At present 19 railway stations in Tamil Nadu have been provided with CCTV surveillance system. Provision of CCTV at remaining railway stations is targeted to be completed by March, 2021.
