- (a) the list of higher education institutions that provide Telugu Language education in the country;
- (b) the student-teacher ratio of Telugu Language department in each such institution;
- (c) the number of teachers of Telugu Language department working on contractual basis in each such institution;
- (d) the steps taken by the Government for publishing of University level text-books in Telugu Language;
- (e) whether the Government has taken any steps for providing Telugu Language education outside the Telugu speaking region of the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

- (a): List of Universities offering programmes in the discipline of Telugu is given in Annexure. Five Central Universities namely Aligarh Muslim University, Banaras Hindu University, University of Delhi, University of Hyderabad and Central University of Andhra Pradesh are offering courses in Telugu language.
- (b): The details of student-teacher ratio in Central Universities offering courses in Telugu language is as under:

University wise details of contract teachers in State Universities are not available with UGC.

(d) to (f): The UGC provides General Development Assistance/Block Grants to all the eligible Universities which can be utilized for providing facilities to all teaching departments including Telugu Language Departments. An amount of Rs.4.25 crore was released to Potti Sreeramulu Telugu University, Hyderabad under General Development Assistance Scheme during XII plan period. The UGC has also been implementing a scheme namely "Funding support to the State Universities for study and research in indigenous and endangered languages in India". Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL) works for the promotion of all Indian languages including Telugu which imparts training to non native school teachers, prospective teachers and general public via ten month diploma course to teachers across the country in all southern languages including Telugu. This centre conducted seminars, workshops and conferences on Telugu language. National Translation Mission (NTM) undertakes translation of higher education texts books including Telugu language.
