Funds for Public and Private Projects

162. SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the release of funds for public/private projects has been pending for the last five years and if so, the details thereof and the reasons for the delay in release of funds, State-wise, particularly Bihar;
- (b) whether there is any State-specific reason for the projects being held up and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the pending projects are concentrated across a few sectors and if so, details thereof; and
- (d) the details of measures taken by the Government to revive the stalled private and public projects especially in the key infrastructure sectors?

(a) to (c): The Union Government allocates funds to the States under Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSSs)/ Central Sector Schemes (CSs) as per scheme guidelines. Most public projects are initiated under approved envelope of CSSs/CSs. Budget is released to State Governments/agencies as per scheme guidelines/GFR. Budgetary provisions are known to Ministries/Departments as soon as Union Budget is approved by the Parliament. Ministry of Finance make releases towards Externally Aided Projects to State Governments. Details for last 5 years are given at Annexure.

(d): The Union Government has set up an institutional mechanism viz. Project Monitoring Group (PMG) for resolving a variety of issues with a view to fast tracking the approvals for setting up and expeditious commissioning of large Public, Private and Public-Private Partnership (PPP) projects. The primary focus of PMG is to expedite the clearances from Central and State Authorities for setting up of projects.
