NEW SIX LANE ROAD BETWEEN TRICHY AND CHENNAI

1700. DR. T.R. PAARIVENDHAR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct a new six lane road between Trichy and Chennai to reduce traffic congestion on the existing road;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time frame set for the purpose?

- (a) to (c) The stretch from Chennai to Trichy of National Highway - 45 has already been 4-laned. To reduce traffic congestion on the existing road stretch, an amount of Rs.56.27 Crore has been sanctioned for 8-laning from Km 28.00 to Km 38.00 (Irumbuliyur - Vandalur – Guduvancherry) within the available ROW. The work in Irumbuliyur- Vandalur and Vandalur to Guduvancherry stretches is targeted for completion by December, 2019 and September, 2020, respectively. Detailed Project Report (DPR) for upgradation of Tambaram (Irumbuliyur) -Tindivanam (93 Km) section has also been initiated.
