- (a): Four airlines are utilising Kannur Airport in Kerala i.e. Air India, Air India Express, Indigo and Go Air.
  - (b): The daily average number of passengers in Kannur Airport has been close to 4000 from 01 January 2019 till 15 November 2019. The highest daily average of 5131 was recorded in August 2019.
  - (c): The viability of airport depends upon revenue and costs of the airport. The major sources of revenue are aeronautical revenue and non-aeronautical revenue. The airport revenue depends upon landing charges and the number of aircrafts landing. The aeronautical charges are determined by AERA.
