†174. SHRI GIRIDHARI YADAV: SHRIMATI RAMA DEVI:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the PRASAD scheme of the Government has been implemented in Bihar;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, location-wise;
- (c) whether any proposal has been sent by the Government of Bihar under PRASAD scheme;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, location-wise and the action taken by the Government so far along with the outcome thereof; and
- (e) the reaction of the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (e): The Ministry has identified Gaya and Patna Sahib as destinations for development under the PRASHAD Scheme in Bihar. The details of projects sanctioned under the scheme are as follows:

- i. "Development of basic facilities at Vishnupad temple, Gaya" sanctioned in 2014-15 at the cost of Rs.4.27 Crore. The amount Rs.2.91 Crore has been released so far.
- ii. "Development of Patna Sahib" sanctioned in 2015-16 at the cost of Rs.41.54 Crore. The amount Rs.33.23 Crore has been released so far.
