- (a) Whether the union Government has received any proposal from the Government of Karnataka regarding phase-III of metro rail projects and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) Whether there is any proposal to link metro rail and sub-urban rail at many points in third phase and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) The funds to be released by the Union Government and the timeline by which the metro phase-III will start?**
