ASSESSMENT OF PMAY-U

NO. 1791. SHRI DHAIRYASHEEL SAMBHAJIRAO MANE: DR. SUJAY RADHAKRISHNA VIKHE PATIL:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of houses sanctioned and completed under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) during the last three years in Maharashtra, district wise;
- (b) the target set for constructing houses under the scheme in urban areas from 2015 to 2022;
- (c) the number of houses handed over to the beneficiaries in Maharashtra during the last three years, district-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government has reviewed the progress of houses constructed under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U) and if so, the details thereof for the period from 2015 to 2018, yearwise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

(a) & (c) The details regarding number of houses sanctioned, completed and occupied under PMAY (U) during last three years in Maharashtra, district-wise are annexed.

- (b) Under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) [PMAY(U)], against an assessed demand of around 1.12 Crore houses in urban areas of the States/UTs, 93.00 lakh houses have so far been sanctioned, of which 55.40 lakh houses have been grounded and 28.06 lakh houses have been completed.
- (d) The Ministry reviews and monitors progress of the projects approved under PMAY (U) through Monthly and Quarterly Progress Reports, in the meetings of Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC), through video conferencing and review meetings at the level of Secretary (HUA) and also through field visits by the officers of the Ministry. 7 CSMC meetings were organized during 2015-16, 13 CSMC meetings were organized during 2017-18.
