CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS IN RAJASTHAN

- (a) the details of the proposals pending for approval for construction of roads in Rajasthan;
- (b) the details and the present status of the work on Jaipur-Delhi Expressway; and
- (c) the funds sanctioned and utilised for the purpose?

ANSWER

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) This Ministry is primarily responsible for the development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs) in the country. 16 proposals amounting to Rs. 2127.52 crore are under consideration under Annual Plan 2019-20.
- (b) & (c) It is proposed to develop 8-lane Delhi-Vadodara Expressway which will have connectivity to Jaipur via Dausa. Consequently, earlier proposal of an Expressway between Delhi and Jaipur has been dropped. The existing Delhi-Jaipur National Highway (NH-8) is presently under BOT (Toll) and construction of structures, wherever required, shall be taken up after the present Concession period is over.
