- (a) whether the attention of the Government has been drawn to the decision of the Government of United States of America to withdraw from the Paris Climate Accord; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof and thereaction of the Government thereto?

#### **ANSWER**

(a) and (b) Government of India is aware that the Government of the United States of America (USA) notified the Secretary-General of United Nations on 4 November 2019 of its decision to withdraw from the Agreement which shall take effect on 4 November 2020 in accordance with article 28 (1) and (2) of the Agreement.

USA is the second largest Greenhouse Gas (GHG)emitter presently. However, if cumulative historical emission is considered, USA would belargest GHG emitter. So, its withdrawal will affect control of cumulative global GHG emissions. It will also affect the availability of international funds for climate change, as USA being a developed country is acontributor to climate finance.
