MEDICAL COLLEGE IN BIJNOR

1980. SHRI MALOOK NAGAR:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has announced to set up a medical college in Bijnor town in Uttar Pradesh, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the time by which the construction work of the said college building is likely to be started; and
- (c) the reasons for non-compliance of the announcement made in 2016 for setting up of medical college in Bijnor, Uttar Pradesh?

(a) to (c): One medical college for district Bijnor in Uttar Pradesh State has been approved under Phase-III of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme for “Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals” at a cost of Rs. 325 crore with fund sharing between the Centre and the State in the ratio of 60:40.

The Phase-III of the Scheme has been approved by the Cabinet on 28.8.2019 to establish 75 more new medical colleges by 2022-23. The implementing agency in this regard is the concerned State Government.
