1981. SHRI HARISH DWIVEDI:

Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the programmes of National

 Doordarshan channel and the number of its viewers;
- (b) whether the Government has allocated/released any amount for improving the programme content of the said channel and number of viewers; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) At present, Doordarshan has 35 operating satellite TV channels which includes 6 all India channels, 17 regional channels, 11 State networks and 1 International channel. These are available on DD FreeDish and approximately 33 million households have access to DD FreeDish throughout the country.
- (b) & (c): Government has allocated Rs.234.51 crore to Doordarshan for content development under the scheme "Broadcasting Infrastructure and Network Development" for the period from 2017-18 to 2019-20.
