- (c) whether the Government proposes to give a big package to bail out knitwear and handloom sector to increase export; and

- (a): India's exports of textile & apparel sector (including handicrafts) have increased from US\$ 39.3 bn in 2017-18 to US\$ 40.4 bn in 2018-19.
- **(b):** India faces competition from countries like Vietnam, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka which enjoy duty free access to key markets. Apparel exports from competing countries enjoy zero/preferential access to EU whereas India faces a duty disadvantage. Besides Bangladesh and Vietnam have a large and productive labour force.
- (c) & (d): There is no such proposal at present.

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
