# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a) & (b): The National Population Stabilization Fund, an autonomous body under Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, was constituted in the year 2000, and implemented the following schemes:
  - 1) Prerna Scheme (for delaying marriage, childbirth and spacing),
  - 2) Santushti Scheme (Public Private Partnership for sterilization services), and
  - 3) National Helpline (for information on family planning).

The Fund has been discontinued on 08/02/2019 vide cabinet decision on 07/02/2018. The performance of the three schemes is placed at Annexure.
