Schools in Assam

2092. SHRI M. BADRUDDIN AJMAL:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the schools and educational centres set up under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) in Assam particularly in Dhubri and Goalpara districts during the last five years;
- (b) the details along with funds released for the purpose during the said period, district-wise and year-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to establish more schools and education centres in Assam particularly in Dhubri and Goalpara districts under SSA keeping in its backwardness;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

(a): The Department of School Education and Literacy has launched an Integrated Scheme for School Education – Samagra Shiksha from 2018-19, subsuming three erstwhile Centrally Sponsored Schemes of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) and Teacher Education (TE). 34 Primary Schools, 47 Upper Primary Schools, 1 Residential school, 1 hostel and 24 Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBV) were approved for Assam during the last five years and the current year. This includes 1 Primary school, 1 Upper Primary school and 2 KGBVs for Goalpara district and 3 KGBVs for Dhubri district of Assam.

As per the information received from the State Government, year-wise details of special training centres for Out of School Children during the period from 2015-16 to 2019-20 is given below :
