KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN BIHAR

2094. DR. ALOK KUMAR SUMAN:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a large number of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Bihar are functioning in temporary buildings including Gopalganj District and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the KVS has taken any steps for construction of permanent building for Kendriya Vidyalayas in the said District by pursuing sponsoring authority in identification of land, completion of lease formalities and all necessary requirements;
- (c) if so, the total funds released for construction of building in Gopalganj; and
- (d) whether the Government has taken up the matter with the State Government for acquisition of land for construction of own building and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) Out of 48 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) in the State of Bihar, 17 KVs namely Bela, Harnaut, Jhajha, Lakhisarai, Buxar, Motihari, Siwan, Banka, Chhapra, AFS (Purnia), CRPF (Jhaphan), Gopalganj, Hajipur, Darbhanga, Baruni, Aurangabad & Maharajganj are running in temporary buildings.

(b) to (d) For construction of permanent buildings for KVs, transfer of land in favour of Kendriya Vidyalayas Sangathan (KVS) by the sponsoring authorities is a pre-requisite. Despite persistent follow up through communications sent on various dates i.e. 26.4.2013, 26.8.2014, 17.6.2015, 29.6.2017, 22.12.2017, 6.2.2018, 7.3.2018, 19.6.2019 & 9.10.2019 the State Government of Bihar has not transferred the requisite extent of the land in favour of KVS and as such, no fund has been released for construction of permanent building for KV, Gopalganj.
