PRIVATE SCHOOLS PROVIDING EDUCATION TO TRIBAL STUDENTS

216. SHRI SAPTAGIRI SANKAR ULAKA:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government provides financial aids/grants to private schools providing education to Tribal students;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and top 10 private institutes being provided financial aids/grants;
- (c) whether the Government audits the grants and verifies if indeed needy tribals are being provided education and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether the Government checks such Private Institutes to see that the culture, heritage, mother tongue of the tribal community is maintained and preserved and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Tribal Affairs provides financial assistance to Voluntary Organisations / Non-Governmental Organisations under the scheme of 'Aid to Voluntary Organisations working for the welfare of Scheduled Tribes' for running and maintenance of residential schools, non-residential schools and educational complexes. Details of top ten organizations which have been given highest amount of funds under the scheme during last three years for running the said schools are at Annex.

(c) & (d): To ensure proper utilization of funds by the NGOs/VOs, audited statements of accounts as well as utilization certificate, duly certified by Chartered Accountants, pertaining to previous releases are invariably obtained. The Ministry considers projects under the scheme based upon the annual inspection carried by the District Authorities and scrutiny & recommendation of multidisciplinary State Level Committee every year. Inspections are also carried out by Officers from Central Government and State Government to oversee the functioning of these schools from time to time.
