SPECIAL PACKAGE TO BOOST TOURISM IN UTS OF KASHMIR AND LADAKH

2175. SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH VERMA:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government plans to announce a special package to boost tourism in the UTs of Kashmir and Ladakh and if so, the details thereof:
- (b) whether the number of tourists has declined in Kashmir in the current year and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to revive tourism in Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh areas?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a): The Ministry of Tourism has not announced any special package to boost tourism in the UTs of Kashmir and Ladakh.
- (b): Ministry of Tourism does not maintain region wise Domestic Tourist Visits (DTVs) and Foreign Tourist Visits (FTVs). However, DTVs and FTVs in respect of erstwhile Jammu and Kashmir State have shown an increase of 19.96% and 74.91% respectively in 2018 over the corresponding period of 2017 as per the following details:
