Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of hospitals of Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) set up in the country including State-wise locations thereof;**
- (b) whether the treatment of patients is taking place there in a proper manner;**
- (c) the State-wise number of hospitals of ESIC constructed in the country during the last five years including present status thereof;**
- (d) the number of hospitals of ESIC set up in Bihar including present status thereof;**
- (e) whether the Government is aware of the status of ESIC hospital set up in Bihar Sharif city of Nalanda district which lacks state-of-the-art facilities; and**
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the efforts being made by the Government to equip Bihar Sharif located ESIC hospital with state-of-the-art facilities?**

ANSWER

(a) & (b): The Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) has set up 49 ESIC hospitals in the country. The state-wise details of these hospitals are placed at Annexure-I.

ESIC hospitals provide primary and secondary care medical facilities viz. out patient care/ inpatient care, drugs, injections and other specialized care in most of the specialities, including facilities under AYUSH. Further, tertiary medical care/Super Specialty Treatment (SST) services are provided in select ESIC hospitals.

(c): The details of the hospitals constructed by the ESIC during the last five years including the present status are placed at Annexure-II.

(d): ESIC has set up two hospitals at Phulwarisharif (Patna) and Bihta in the State of Bihar. These hospitals provide primary and secondary care services in most of the specialties.

(e): No ESIC Hospital has been set up in Bihar Sharif in the Nalanda district of Bihar.

(f): Does not arise in view of (e) above.
