Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any proposal has been received from Maharashtra for establishing Skill Development Mission/Centres during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the results of the action of according necessary approval in this regard and the response of the Government thereto; and
- (d) the funds allocated by the Union Government to Maharashtra for the purpose?

(a) to (d) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) in the country including State of Maharashtra. This Scheme enables the youth for taking Short Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) through accredited and affiliated training centers (TCs) throughout the country. Under the scheme, as on 11.11.2019, 69.03 Lakh (approx.) candidates have been trained in diverse sectors in the country. Out of these, 6,04,153 candidates have been trained in the State of Maharashtra.

PMKVY 2016-20 has two components known as Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) being implemented by National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) being implemented by State Skill Development Missions of the States/ UTs popularly known as State- Engagement Component of PMKVY (2016-20).

Under CSCM component of PMKVY 2016-20, there is no provision for State-wise allocation of funds. Under this component, funds are being released to NSDC which are subsequently released by NSDC on reimbursement basis at various stages of training (commencement of the training after validation, successful certification and placement) to the empanelled training providers and centres.

Under CSSM component of PMKVY 2016-20, 25% of the funds and corresponding physical targets of PMKVY 2016-20 has been allocated to the States for the implementation of scheme through State Skill Development Missions. Under this component, Ministry has allocated Rs. 214.44 Crore funds to the State of Maharashtra for 4 years (2016-20). On the basis of performance of State, till now Rs. 85.77 Crore have been released under CSSM-PMKVY.

Additionally, MSDE through NSDC also promotes establishment of model and aspirational skill centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) in every district throughout the country for imparting skill training through PMKVY 2016-20. MSDE through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) provides capital expenditure upto 75% of the project investment as well as operational support to each PMKK. As on date, a total of Rs. 14.18 crores have been disbursed towards the establishment of PMKK centres in Maharashtra. As on date, 50 PMKKs have been allocated in 36 districts of Maharashtra. Out of allocated PMKKs, 41 PMKKs have been already established.
