- (a) to (c): A news article on discrepancy in purchase of medicines for State Government run ESIS hospitals in Telangana and consequential arrest of an official published in newspaper, has been reported to Employees' State Insurance Corporation, (ESIC), New Delhi.
- (d): From time to time, ESIC issues guidelines to various State Governments for procurement of medicines through ESIC Rate Contract/State Rate Contract including compliance of General Financial Rules.
