(a) & (b): As on 30.09.2019, there are 21181 personnel posted against sanctioned strength of 42038 in FCI. The category-wise details is as follows:

During last 05 years, 5494 vacancies have been filled in FCI for Cat-I, II and III Officers/officials.

For the post of Watchman (cat-IV), 984 candidates have joined against the 3491 vacancies advertised as below:
