TERRORIST INFILTRATION

2420. SHRI KOMATI REDDY VENKAT REDDY:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the terrorist infiltration into Jammu and Kashmir is higher in 2018 in comparison with the last five years;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and**
- (c) the corrective measures being taken by the Government to ward off such infiltration in future?**

(a) & (b) The number of estimated net infiltration in Jammu and Kashmir during the last five years and current year (upto October, 2019) are as under: -

Year	Estimated Net infiltration
2014	65
2015	36
2016	119
2017	136
2018	143
2019 (upto October)	114

Pursuant to Government's policy of zero tolerance against terrorism, the security forces are taking proactive action against terrorists. Due to concerted and synergized efforts of security forces, a large number of terrorists have been neutralized in Jammu and Kashmir in the past few years. With nefarious designs

to instigate and sustain terrorism, training and infiltration of such trained terrorists is being actively sponsored and supported from across the border.

(c) Government of India has adopted a multi-pronged approach to contain cross border infiltration. This includes multi-tiered deployment along the International Border / Line of Control, border fencing, improved intelligence and operational coordination, equipping Security Forces with advanced weapons and taking proactive action against infiltrators.
