Construction of Fishing Harbour in Andhra Pradesh

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

- (a) the time by which the State Government of Andhra Pradesh submitted proposal for construction of a fishing harbour in Nizampatnam in Guntur district of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) whether it is true that the project cost is estimated to be Rs. 340 crore; and
- (c) if so, the status of the project and the time by which it is likely to be completed and operational?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) : The Government of Andhra Pradesh has submitted a proposal for construction of fishing harbour at Nizampatnam in Guntur District at an estimated cost of Rs. 340.78 crore and sought the concessional finance under the Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF). The proposal of Government of Andhra Pradesh for construction of the fishing harbour at Nizampatnam at an estimated cost of Rs 340.78 crore has been recommended restricting the interest subvention upto 3% per annum by the Government of India for the project cost of Rs 150 crore under the provisions of Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF).
