Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any scheme for relocation and prelocation of several head offices of Department of Posts is under consideration of the Government and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether Head Post Office situated at Osmanabad for the last 47 years jointly for Osmanabad and Latur districts has been relocated at Latur temporarily/irregularly;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) whether the Government proposes to take any action to prelocate the already established Head Post Office, which provides suitable and all facilities to the common people from Latur to Osmanabad and if so, the details thereof along with the time limit fixed therefor?
