Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the ambitious projects of the Railways for capacity expansion by way of gauge conversion and doubling of railway lines has come to a standstill for non-receipt of environmental clearance;
- (b) if so, the location/project-wise details thereof;
- (c) whether the revenue loss and the occurrence of delay has been assessed;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Ministry of Environment has been urged by the Railways to speed up the process of granting approval in a time-bound manner on a fast-track mode;
- (f) if so, the reaction thereto; and
- (g) the other measures taken to obtain environmental clearance to the said projects?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (g) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.2740 BY SHRI RAVI KISHAN AND SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH JOSHI TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 04.12.2019 REGARDING ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR RAILWAY PROJECTS

(a), (b) and (g): Railway projects do not require environmental clearance. However, forestry/wild life clearances are required, wherever the diversion of forest land is involved. Taking permission from Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) is an integral part of project execution.

Presently, Indian Railways have taken up 18 doubling and 05 gauge conversion projects with Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC) and concerned State Governments for obtaining forestry/wild-life clearance/tree cutting permission. List of projects for which forestry/wild-life clearance/tree cutting permission has been taken up is appended.

In this regard, regular meetings with the officials of MoEF&CC and State Governments are being held to expedite forestry/wild-life clearance/tree cutting permission for Railway Projects, so that, Railway Projects are completed expeditiously.

- (c): No, Sir.

- (f): MoEF&CC has issued instruction to zonal units, advising them that, if the land is Railway land (i.e. ownership of the land vests with Railways) and which is under 'non-forest use' before 25th October 1980, then, provisions of Forest Conservation Act would not apply.
