#### **Promotion of New Systems of Aquaculture**

#### †275. SHRI SUNIL KUMAR PINTU:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पश्पालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether concrete steps have been taken or are being taken by the Government to promote biofloc and re-circulating acquaculture system for fisheries;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the schemes being run by the Government for construction of new ponds in addition to revival of dying ponds for fisheries?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRYAND DAIRYING (SHRI PRATAP CHANDRA SARANGI)

- (a) and (b): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India since 2015-16 has been implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries with a total central outlay of Rs.3000 crore for development of fisheries in the country including promotion of innovative technology in the field of fisheries and aquaculture. The CSS *inter-alia* provides financial assistance to the State Governments/UTs for taking up innovative activities and adoption of new technologies such as Re-circulatory Aquaculture System (RAS) etc. Under the CSS 398 units of Re-circulatory Aquaculture System (RAS) with central share of Rs.26.805 crore have been taken up during the past four years 2015-16 to 2018-19.
- (c) Under the CSS on Blue Revolution: Integrated Development and Management of Fisheries financial assistance is provided for development of freshwater and brackish water aquaculture including construction of ponds, renovation of existing ponds/tanks, renovation of MNERGA ponds and tanks, rejuvenation of Urban/ Semi-Urban/ Rural Lakes/Tanks for fish culture including input costs. Besides, the Fisheries Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) inter-alia provides concessional finance for development of infrastructure for aquaculture.
