Will the Minister of **JAL SHAKTI** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether toilets have been constructed in the State of Odisha after commencement of the scheme of 'Clean India Toilet';
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the number of toilets constructed;
- (c) whether the funds allocated by the Government have been utilized completely;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) There is no such scheme with the name of 'Clean India Toilet'. However, 68,36,650 individual household latrines (IHHLs) have been constructed in Odisha under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) [SBM(G)] as on 02-12-2019 as per the data reported by the State on the online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS).

(c) to (e) Year-wise details of funds released by the Government of India to Odisha under SBM(G) and their utilization by the State as per the Utilization Certificates (UCs)/Provisional UCs furnished by the State are given below:
