- (a) the number of persons belonging to weaker sections who have been allotted houses under various schemes in Maharashtra during the last three years;**
- (b) the estimated number of persons in that State who are homeless; and**
- (c) the outcome of the 'Housing for All' scheme?**

**(a) Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs has sanctioned 9,03,689 houses for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) during the last three years under various components of Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) [PMAY(U)] in Maharashtra.**

**(b) As per Census 2011, homeless population in urban area of Maharashtra is 1,11,373.**

**(c) Under PMAY(U), 93.18 lakh houses have been sanctioned as on 25.11.2019 against validated demand of 112 lakh houses in various States/Union Territories. Out of the sanctioned houses, 55.86 lakh houses have been grounded for construction of which 28.36 lakh houses have been completed.**
