INDUSTRIES USING WATER FROM DAMS AND CANALS

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the industries permitted to utilise water from dams and canals for their use in the country at present;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to formulate regulation to promote major industries to construct dams and canals to exploit the water resources for their use;
- (c) if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether any proposal has been received for the industries in this regard; and
- (e) if so, the details and the outcome thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (e) Water being a State subject, the respective State Governments allocate water for different purposes as per their priorities and requirements. National Water Policy, 2012 inter-alia states that safe water for drinking and sanitation should be considered as pre-emptive needs, followed by high priority allocation for other basic domestic needs (including needs of animals), achieving food security, supporting sustenance agriculture and minimum eco-system needs. Available water, after meeting the above needs, should be allocated in a manner to promote its conservation and efficient use. The utilization of water by industries from dam/canals is for consumptive and/or non-consumptive purposes. The details of the industries permitted to utilise water from dams and canals for their use is not available.
