POST-MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

2812. SHRI P. RAVEENDRANATH KUMAR:

Will the Minister of MINORITY AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has launched post-matric scholarship scheme to the students of medical and engineering courses belonging to Minority Community;
- (b) if so, the status of the implementation of the scheme, State-wise; and
- (c) the amount of the said post-matric scholarship to be granted, class-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI)

- (a): Scholarship, under the Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme is awarded for studies in India in a government or private higher secondary school, college, universityincluding such residential institutes of the Government and eligible private institutes selected and notified in a transparent manner by the State Government/Union Territory Administration concerned. It also covers technical and vocational courses in Industrial Training Institutes/ Industrial Training Centres affiliated with the National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) of classes XI and XII level including Polytechnics and other courses. Any course of less than one year duration and certificate courses are not covered under Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme.
- (b): The status of state wise implementation of the Scheme, in terms of number of Scholarships awarded so far is given the annexure.
- (c): The rate of Scholarship under the Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme is given in the table below:
