FREEDOM FIGHTERS' MEMORIALS

NO. 2835. SHRI RAM MOHAN NAIDU KINJARAPU:

Will the MINISTER OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of memorials erected in the honour of freedom fighters along with expenditure incurred for each of them in the past five years;
- (b) whether the Government has erected any memorial in the capital city, Delhi in the honour of freedom fighters from Andhra Pradesh and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government proposes to erect a National Memorial in the honour of women freedom fighters and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) OF THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI HARDEEP SINGH PURI)

- (a): The National Salt Satyagraha Memorial at Dandi, Gujarat was constructed by Central Public Works Department (CPWD) for Ministry of Culture at a cost of Rs. 59.28 Crores and Dr. Ambedkar National Memorial at Delhi was constructed by CPWD for Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment at a cost of Rs. 99.64 Crores.
- (b): No such work has been done by CPWD.
- (c): There is no such proposal at present with Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.
